

## 2010 – 2011 Qabats Volunteer Positions

### Workshop leader (32 volunteer positions):

There are 4 rotations that are 5 weeks long. Becky D'Angelo-Veitch will begin each rotation with a presentation of the story to the whole group followed by 4 weeks of workshops led by volunteers. We believe this will make workshops a better learning experience for our kids, and easier to lead as the kids will have a basic understanding of the story.

Themes for 2010/2011 are:

Rotation 1: The Call of Samuel, 1 Samuel 3

Rotation 2: Light, John 1

Rotation 3: Growing Gods Garden, Parable of Sower

Rotation 4: Bible Basics, consult with Becky re: topics and workshops

Workshops tie into a central Bible story that is explored in a variety of different ways, such as: arts & crafts, Bible skills & games, drama or audio-visual/computers. Volunteers are encouraged to bring their own skills and ideas to our workshops. However, you are also encouraged to contact a Qabats leader for ideas and support.

For every theme, we need 8 teachers (2 per workshop). Volunteers who choose to serve as ***workshop leaders are asked to conduct two workshops*** per program year. Generally, the time commitment will be 5:15 – 7:40 pm.

### Table Parent (14 volunteer positions):

The table parent commitment is an ***every week*** commitment, but table parents are only required to be present from 6:00-7:30 pm. This involves being a friendly face, assisting the children during dinner and managing dinnertime behavior. Each dinner table has **one permanent** table parent and five kids.

In addition to dinnertime supervision, table parents are asked to assist with setting and clearing tables while we are at Incarnate Word.

### **Kitchen Crew (10 Volunteer positions):**

Because of the time we have in the kitchen at Incarnate Word (IW), we will continue to have pre-ordered meals; therefore, NO KITCHEN CREW will be needed while we are at IW. However, once we are back at Third (January 2011) a kitchen crew is necessary.

**If you are interested in signing up for Kitchen Crew, please do so and ALSO sign up to assist during a Rotation 1 or 2 Workshop.**

Once we are back at Third, the kitchen crew will be divided into two teams who alternate weeks. This *every-other-week commitment* involves preparing, serving and cleaning up the meal. Volunteers are needed from 5:15-7:30 pm.

### **Childcare (4 volunteer positions):**

### **“The Early Show” (1 volunteer position):**

While we are guests at Incarnate Word, **we are not able to offer an early show** to children who arrive early (October 2010 – January 2011). If your child will be at IW between 5–5:30pm, please be sure they are supervised by an adult.

Once we are back at Third, we will provide this service. “The Early Show” provides adult supervision for children of volunteers who need to be at Qabats early and siblings of bell choir members. This program runs from 5:00-5:30pm, and requires a volunteer to supervise kids. Kids are asked to bring homework or a book to read during this time.
