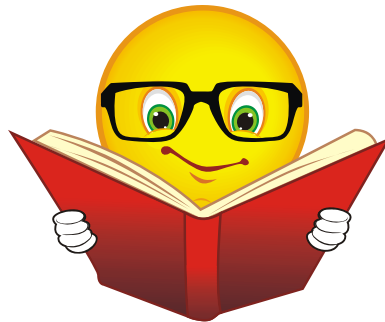
Research says....

If students are not reading on grade level by Grade 3, they will probably never catch up.



Research says....

Adult tutor programs that have consistency can have a major impact on a student's academic achievement.

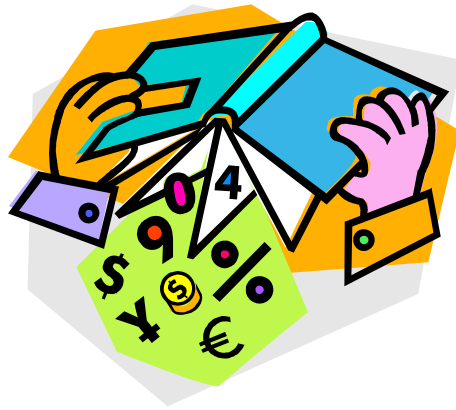


Let's look at the School #6 Tutoring Program!



Let's Look at the DATA!

- 1-1 Tutor Data
- Compares September 2009 DRA Data with January 2010 Data



School #6 Student Growth

All but 7 students at School #6
made reading growth



School #6 1-1 Tutored Students

- 98% made reading growth
- 98% grew two or more reading levels or within level
- 20% are now reading on grade level



Digging deeper into the data shows....

- Only 1 Grade 1 student is still at K level
- All Grade 2 students are nearing the end of Gr. 1 reading



Digging deeper into the data shows....

- Grade 3 students grew an average of 3 or more levels
- Grade 4 and 5 students who were at the beginning of their levels are at the end-cusp of grade level reading
