

WORSHIP PARTICIPATION expectations

Development of a growing understanding of worship, and our contribution to it - being a part of the whole community of the church offering praise and prayer - is an important part of what singing in a youth choir is all about. To that end, on Sundays when youth are singing, we expect the following:

- that youth be on time for warm up (usually one hour before worship – see the schedule for specific times)
- that youth will sit as a group and participate in the entire service on those days, respecting those in the congregation worshipping around them
- that youth will not be available to assist in church school on those Sundays (teachers are notified of the dates when youth will be absent...)
- on Sundays when youth are ringing, and not singing, that they will sit with their families – or as a group somewhere *other than* in the bell balcony

DRESS for Singing in Church

Covenant Singers will wear navy or black pants/skirts and white shirts/blouses – guys wear a straight tie – dark shoes for everyone.
